# Economic Growth Region 10

Economic Growth Region (EGR) 10 includes Clark, Crawford, Floyd, Harrison, Scott, and Washington Counties.

## Regional and State Unemployment (seasonally adjusted)

Regional and state unemployment rates were generally little changed or higher in October. Twenty-nine states and the District of Columbia recorded over-the-month unemployment rate increases, 13 states registered rate decreases, and eight states had no rate change, reported the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Over the year, jobless rates increased in all 50 states and the District of Columbia. The national unemployment rate rose to 10.2 percent in October 2009.

## Metropolitan Area Unemployment (not seasonally adjusted)

The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported that unemployment rates were higher in October than a year earlier in all 372 metropolitan areas. Fifteen areas recorded jobless rates of at least 15.0 percent, while 13 areas registered rates below 5.0 percent. The national unemployment rate in October was 9.5 percent, not seasonally adjusted.





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
