Statistical data report for December 2010, Released February 2011

Economic Growth Region (EGR) 10 includes Clark, Crawford, Floyd, Harrison, Scott, and Washington Counties.

Economic Growth Region 10

Regional and State Unemployment (seasonally adjusted)

Regional and state unemployment rates were generally little changed in December. Twenty states recorded unemployment rate increases, fifteen states and the District of Columbia registered rate decreases, and fifteen states had no rate change, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported today. Thirty-one states and the District of Columbia posted unemployment rate decreases from a year earlier, sixteen states reported increases and three states had no change. The national jobless rate fell by 0.4 percentage point between November and December to 9.4 percent, 0.5 percent lower than in December 2009.

In December non-farm payroll employment decreased in thirty-five states and the District of Columbia and increased in fifteen states. The largest over-the-month employment decreases were in New York (-22,800), Minnesota (-22,400), Florida (-17,900) and Georgia (-17,500). The largest over-the-month increases in employment occurred in Texas (+20,000) and South Carolina (+9,000).






