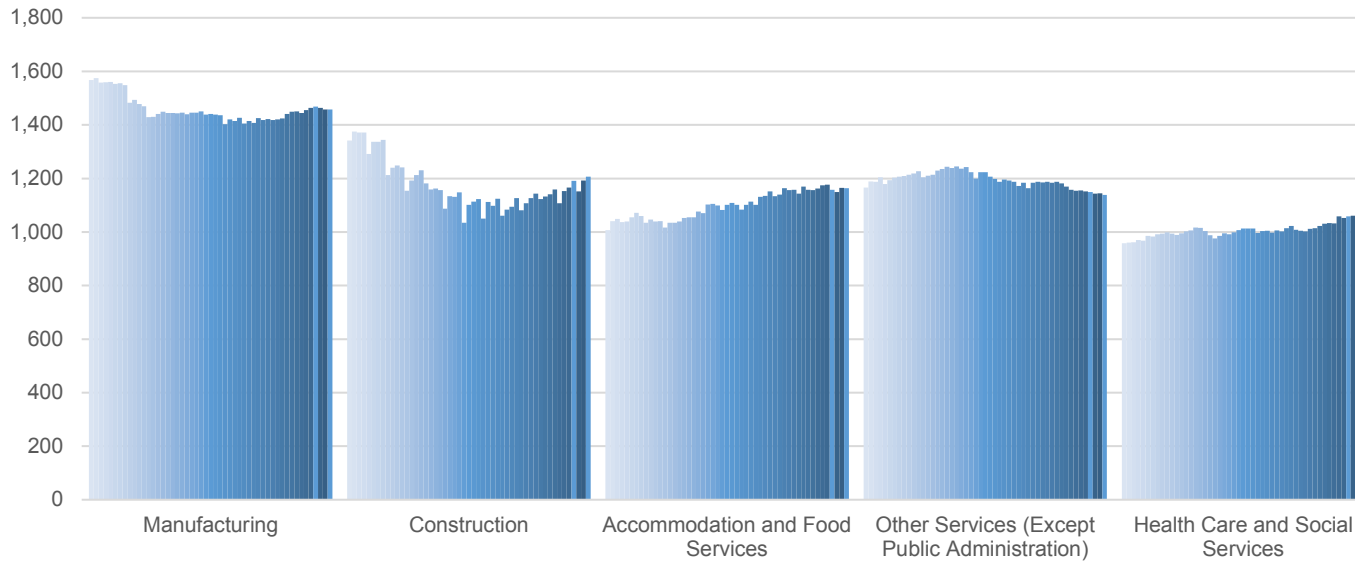

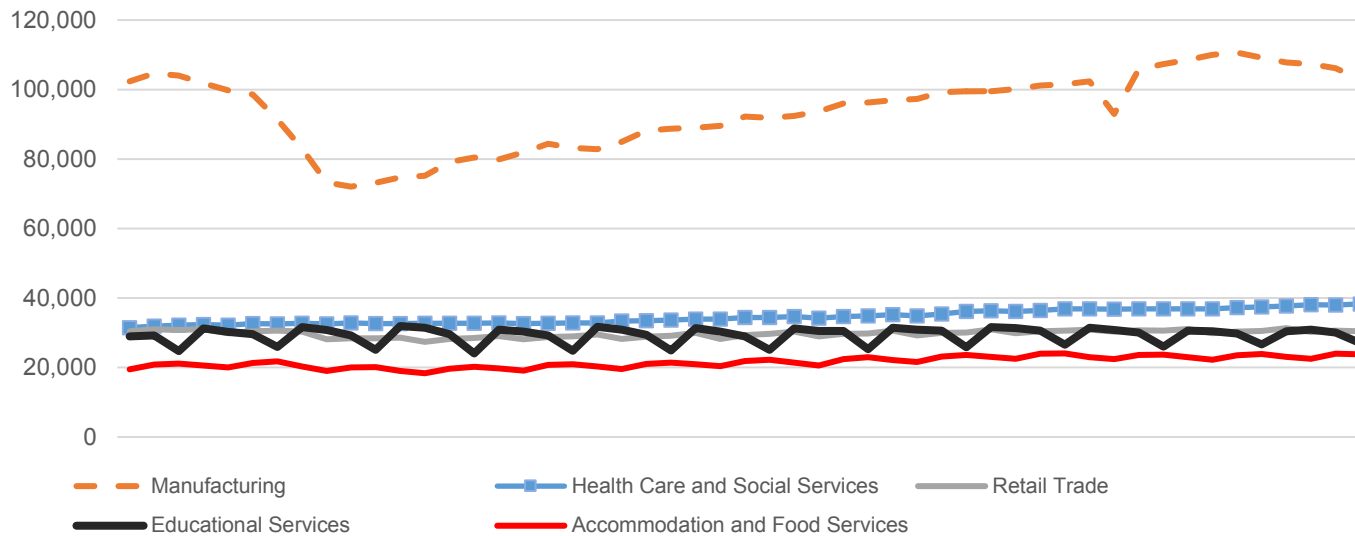

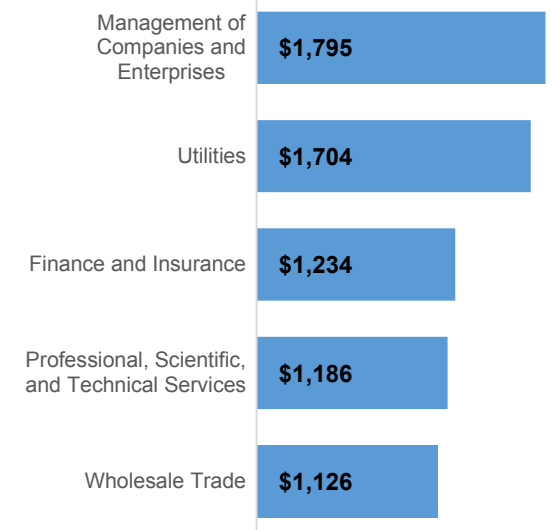
Historic Trend of Top 5 Largest Industries by Establishments
