Economic Growth Region 9

Regional and State Unemployment (seasonally adjusted)

Regional and state unemployment rates were generally lower in November. Thirty-six states and the District of Columbia recorded over-the-month unemployment rate decreases, eight states registered rate increases, and six states had no rate change, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported. Over the year, jobless rates increased in all 50 states and the District of Columbia.

In November, the West reported the highest regional jobless rate, 10.6 percent, while the Northeast recorded the lowest rate, 8.7 percent. These two regions experienced the only statistically significant over-the-month rate changes--the Northeast, -0.3 percentage point, and the West, -0.2 point. Over the year, all four regions registered significant rate increases, the largest of which was in the West (+3.4 percentage points).

Economic Growth Region (EGR) 9 includes Bartholomew, Dearborn, Decatur, Franklin, Jackson, Jefferson, Jennings, Ohio, Ripley, and Switzerland Counties.




EGR 9 Monthly Unemployment Claims by Industry - November 2009




