## Economic Growth Region 8

### Regional and State Unemployment (seasonally adjusted)

The Bureau of Labor Statistics of the U.S. Department of Labor reported that regional and state unemployment rates were generally higher in June. Thirty-eight states and the District of Columbia recorded over-the-month unemployment rate increases, five states registered rate decreases, and seven states had no rate change.

Economic Growth Region (EGR) 8 includes: Brown, Daviess, Greene, Lawrence, Martin, Monroe, Orange and Owen Counties.

### Percent of Total Distribution




