## Economic Growth Region 9

### Regional and State Unemployment (seasonally adjusted)

Regional and state unemployment rates were generally higher in June. Thirty-eight states and the District of Columbia recorded over-the-month unemployment rate increases, five states registered rate decreases, and seven states had no rate change, the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the U.S. Department of Labor reported. Over the year, jobless rates were higher in all fifty states and the District of Columbia.

In June, the Midwest and West reported the highest regional jobless rates, 10.2 percent each. The Northeast recorded the lowest rate, 8.6 percent. Three of the 4 regions registered statistically significant rate changes from the previous month: the Midwest (+0.4 percentage point) and the Northeast and South (+0.3 point each).

Economic Growth Region (EGR) 9 includes Bartholomew, Dearborn, Decatur, Franklin, Jackson, Jefferson, Jennings, Ohio, Ripley, and Switzerland Counties.







## Applicant Pool: Top Ten Occupations Selected by Applicant Resumes in the Past Twelve Months


