## Greene, Indiana (18055)

Greene is one of 92 counties in Indiana. It is part of the Bloomington, IN (MSA). Its 2005 population of 33,408 ranked 49th in the state.

### PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Greene had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$25,704. This PCPI ranked 69th in the state and was 82 percent of the state average, \$31,173, and 75 percent of the national average, \$34,471. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.4 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 4.2 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Greene was \$17,103 and ranked 79th in the state. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 4.2 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 3.8 percent and for the nation was 4.1 percent.

### TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Greene had a total personal income (TPI) of \$858,729\*. This TPI ranked 53rd in the state and accounted for 0.4 percent of the state total. In 1995 the TPI of Greene was \$556,993\* and ranked 51st in the state. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 3.4 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 state change was 4.2 percent and the national change was 5.2 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.5 percent and for the nation was 5.2 percent.

### COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Greene. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 66.2 percent of TPI (compared with 64.7 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 13.2 percent (compared with 17.3 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.6 percent (compared with 18.0 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 2.2 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 1.9 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.2 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 4.7 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 1.6 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.9 percent.

### EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Greene increased from \$310,178\* in 2004 to \$323,688\* in 2005, an increase of 4.4 percent. The 2004-2005 state change was 3.4 percent and the national change was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$232,139\* to the 2005 estimate was 3.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the state was 4.6 percent and for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*Note:* All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.
