## Anderson, IN (11300)

Anderson is one of 361 Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) in the nation. Its 2005 population of 130,389 ranked 281st in the nation.

### PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Anderson had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$28,688. This PCPI ranked 227th in the United States and was 83 percent of the national average, \$34,471. The 2005 PCPI reflected an increase of 3.1 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 4.2 percent. In 1995 the PCPI of Anderson was \$20,294 and ranked 189th in the United States. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.5 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.1 percent.

### TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2005 Anderson had a total personal income (TPI) of \$3,740,594\*. This TPI ranked 281st in the United States. In 1995 the TPI of Anderson was \$2,714,464\* and ranked 250th in the United States. The 2005 TPI reflected an increase of 3.0 percent from 2004. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.2 percent. The 1995-2005 average annual growth rate of TPI was 3.3 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.2 percent.

### COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Anderson. In 2005 net earnings accounted for 67.8 percent of TPI (compared with 67.8 in 1995); dividends, interest, and rent were 11.5 percent (compared with 15.7 in 1995); and personal current transfer receipts were 20.7 percent (compared with 16.4 in 1995). From 2004 to 2005 net earnings increased 1.4 percent; dividends, interest, and rent increased 3.2 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 8.6 percent. From 1995 to 2005 net earnings increased on average 3.3 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent remained unchanged; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.7 percent.

### EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Anderson decreased from \$2,187,700\* in 2004 to \$2,173,002\* in 2005, a decrease of 0.7 percent. The 2004-2005 national change was 5.6 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1995 estimate of \$1,891,451\* to the 2005 estimate was 1.4 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.5 percent.

*Note:* All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.
