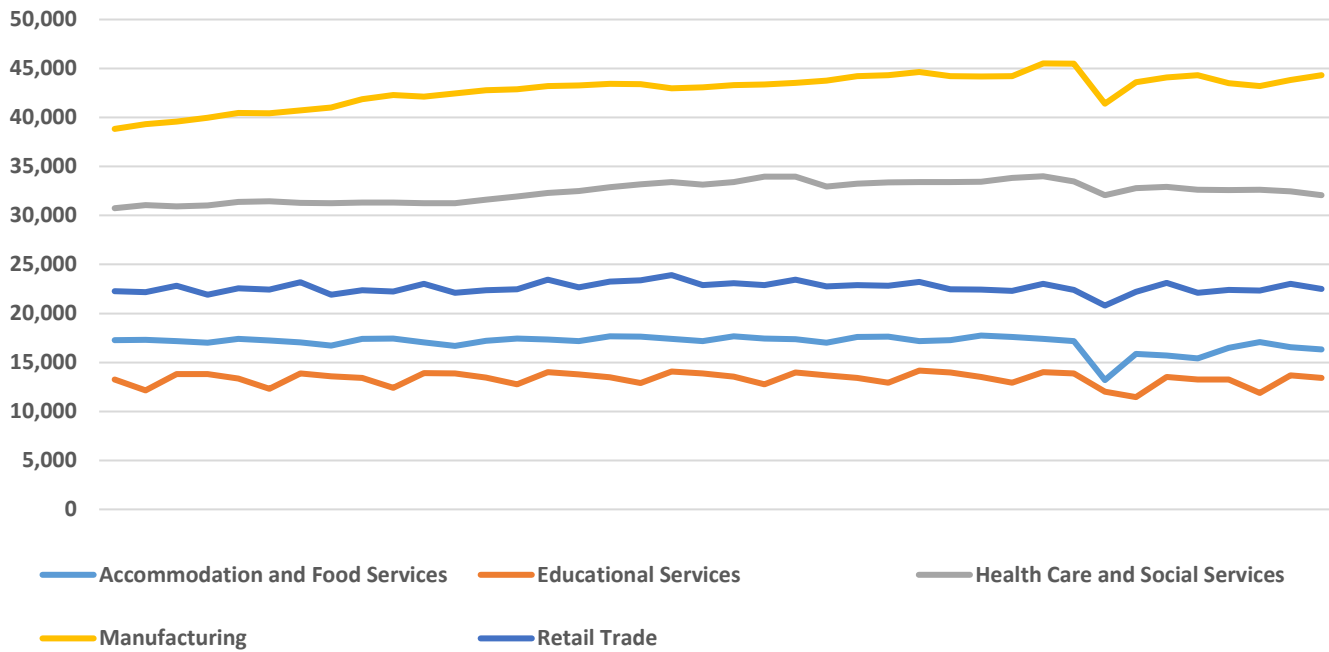

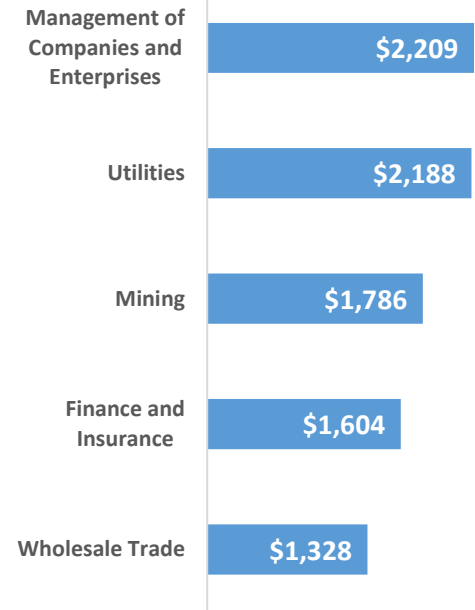

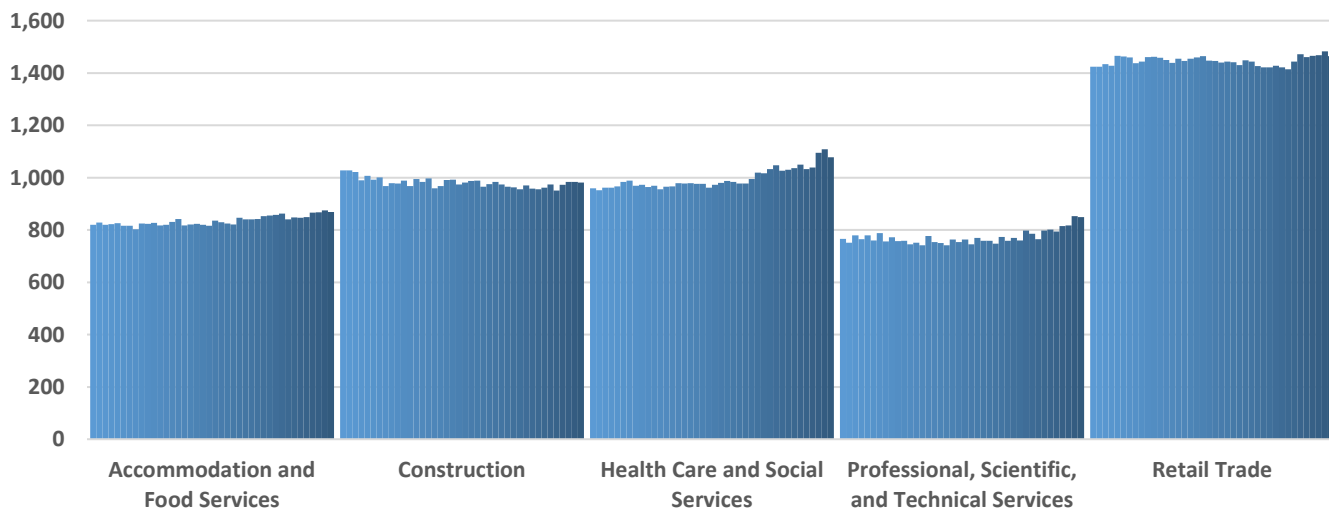
### Top 5 Largest Industries by Jobs (past 10 years)
