State Employment and Unemployment

STATE EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT -- DECEMBER 2023 Unemployment rates were higher in December in 15 states, lower in 1 state, and stable in 34 states and the District of Columbia, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported. Eighteen states and the District had jobless rate increases from a year earlier, 15 states had decreases, and 17 states had little change. The national unemployment rate was unchanged at 3.7 percent but was 0.2 percentage point higher than in December 2022. Nonfarm payroll employment was essentially unchanged in all 50 states and the District of Columbia in December 2023. Over the year, nonfarm payroll employment increased in 30 states and was essentially unchanged in 20 states and the District.





Real Earnings Summary

REAL EARNINGS - DECEMBER 2023

Real average hourly earnings for all employees increased 0.2 percent from November to December, seasonally adjusted, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported. This result stems from an increase of 0.4 percent in average hourly earnings combined with an increase of 0.3 percent in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U). Real average weekly earnings decreased 0.2 percent over the month due to the change in real average hourly earnings combined with a 0.3-percent decrease in the average workweek. Real average hourly earnings increased 0.8 percent, seasonally adjusted, from December 2022 to December 2023. The change in real average hourly earnings combined with a decrease of 0.3 percent in the average workweek resulted in a 0.5-percent increase in real average weekly earnings over this period. 


