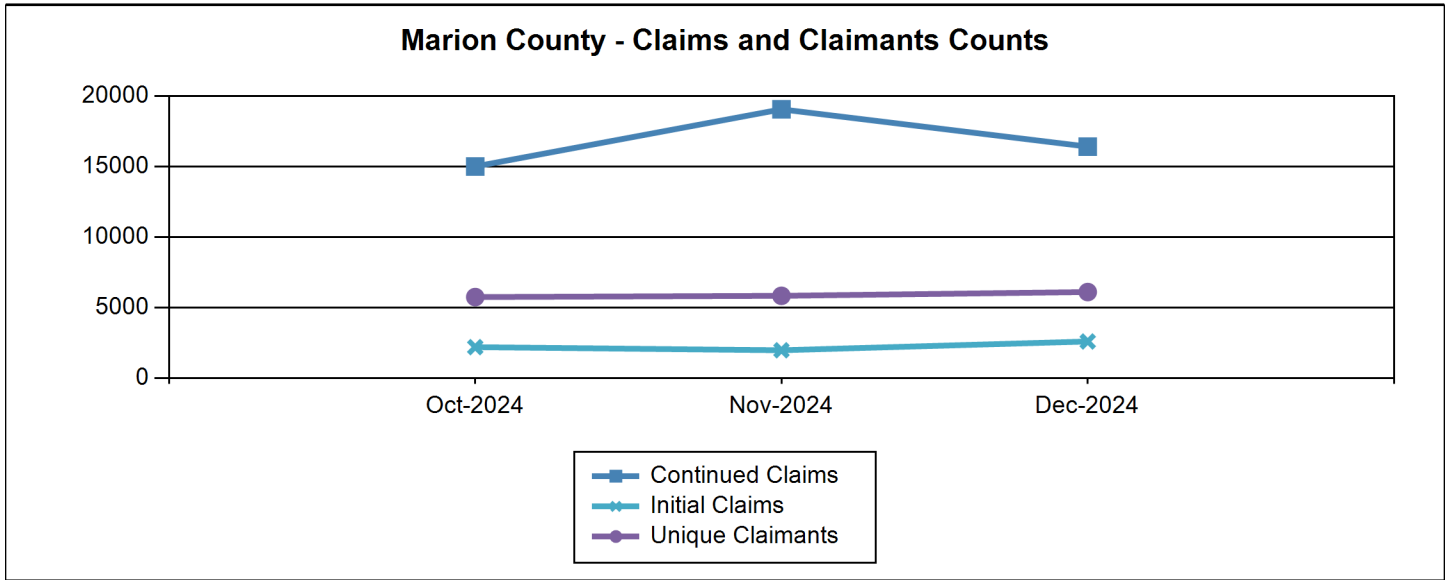

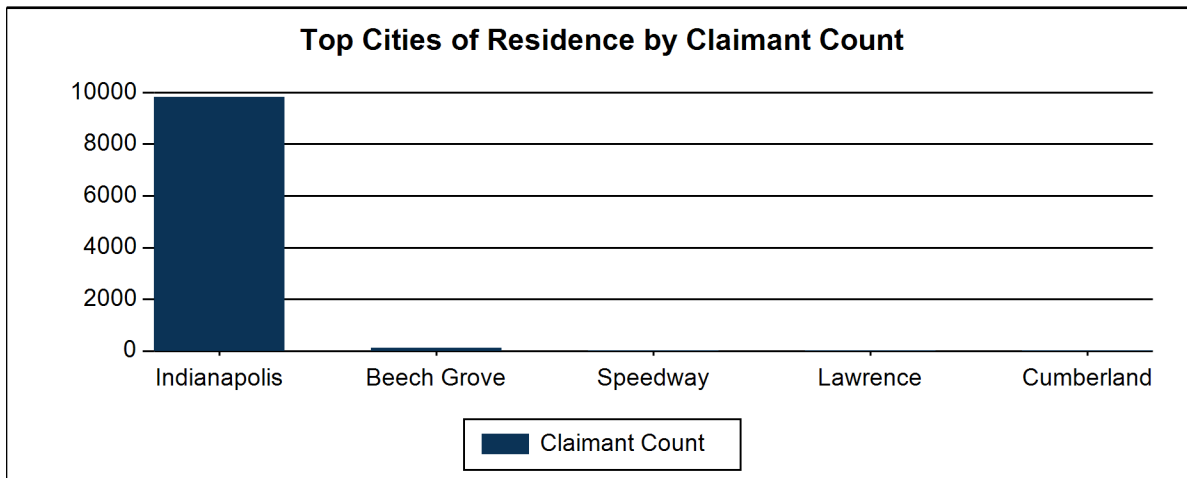

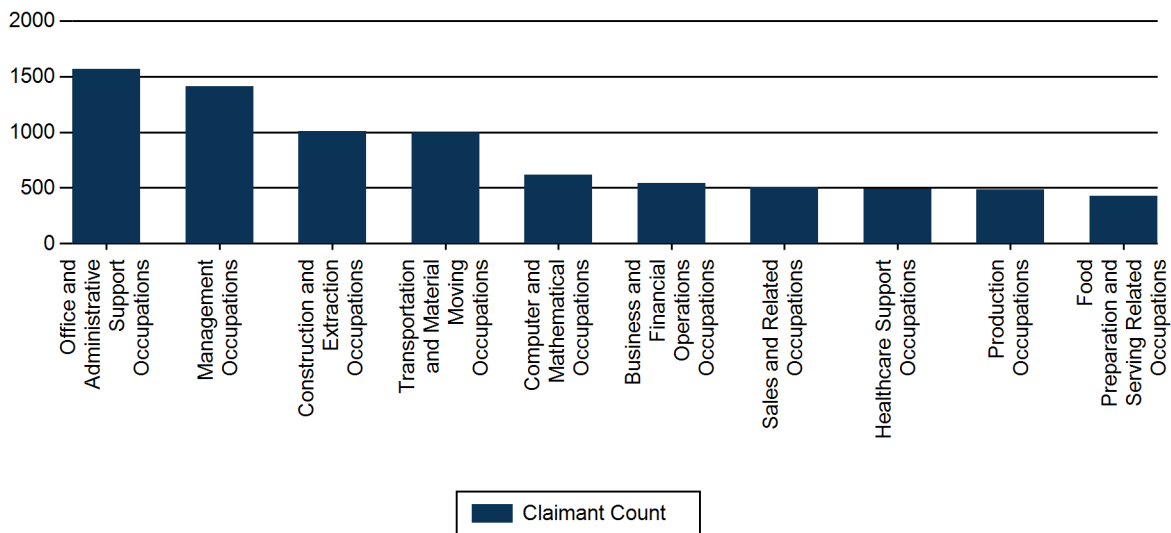

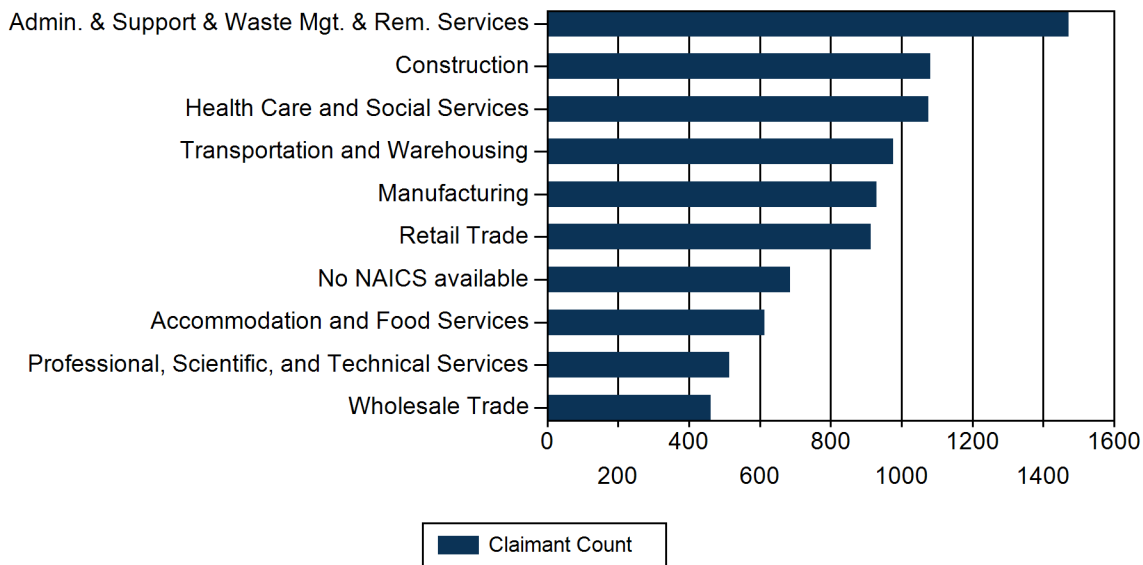

**Top 10 Industries by NAICS by Claimant Count**



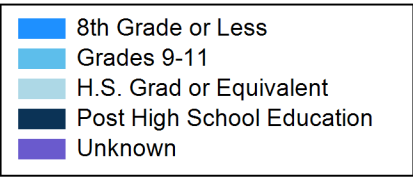
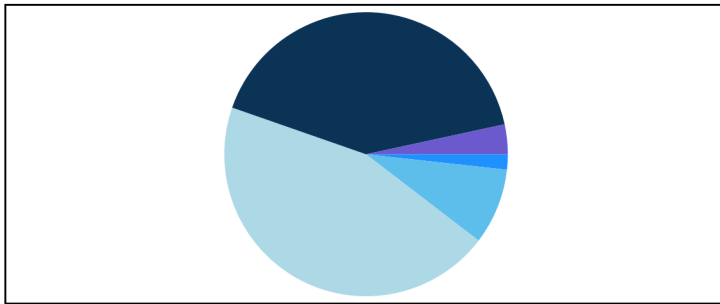

Claimant Count by Education Attainment





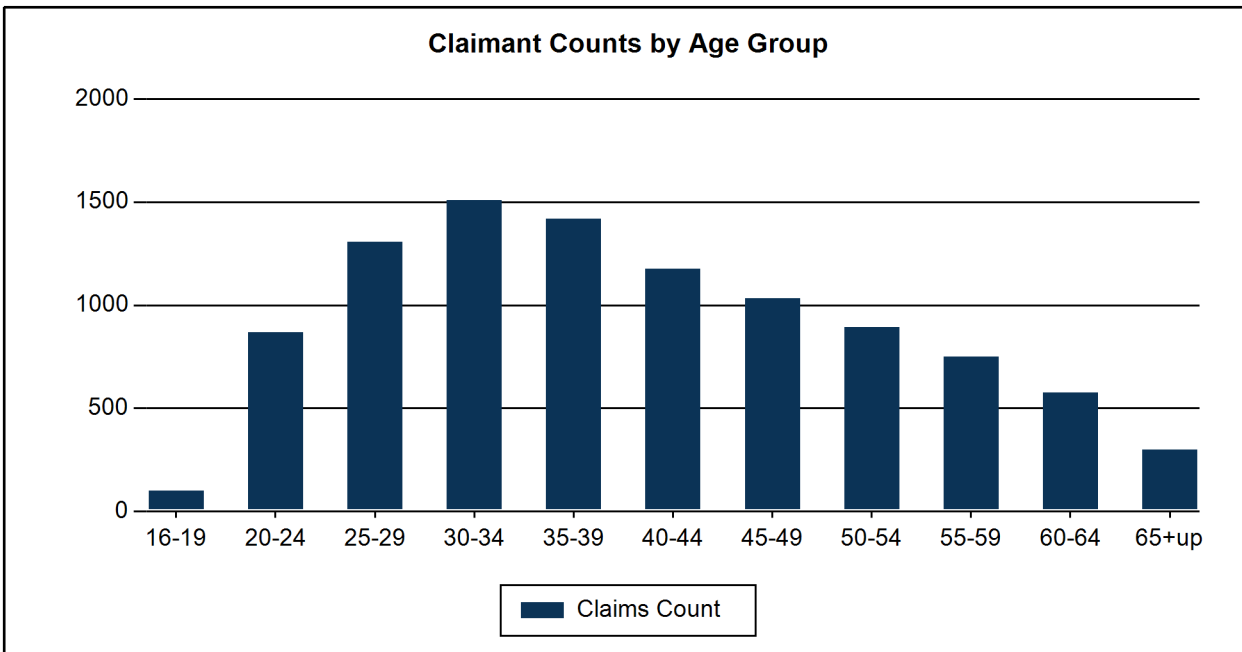
